Federal Trade Commission-Fraud Alert

A fraud alert can make it harder for an identity thief to open more accounts in your name. You can place a fraud alert by asking one of the three nationwide credit bureaus. It has to put the alert on your credit report and tell the other two credit bureaus to do so. The alert lasts one year. <https://www.consumer.ftc.gov/articles/0275-place-fraud-alert>
